We are surrounded by signs of change and growth - from the growth of the building itself to the 500 or so new hedge saplings that form the new boundary in the playground.

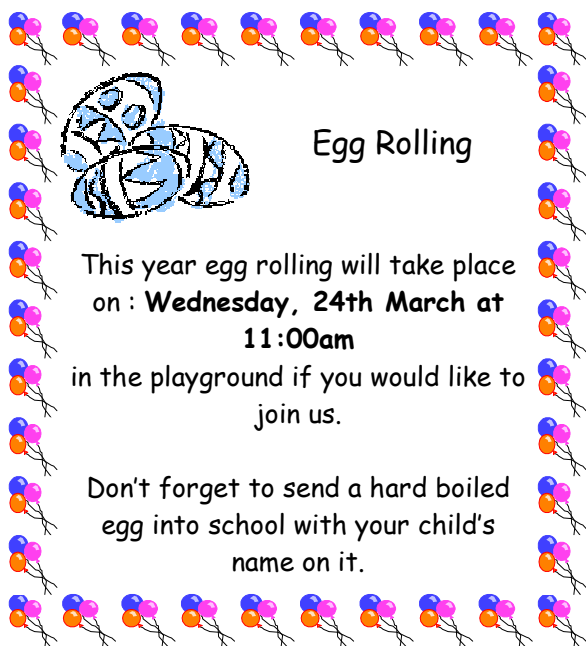

This year egg rolling will take place on : **Wednesday, 24th March at 11:00am**

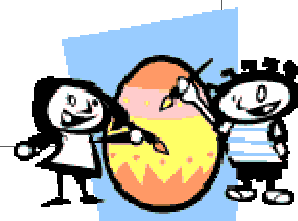
