We are pleased to announce that after the Christmas break we will be accepting payments online for **dinner money**. **Please can you sign up for Parent Pay if your child currently has free school meals in Classes 1 and 2, as this will be the new way that we inform the kitchen of the dinner numbers each day, so every child needs to be registered.**

Using a secure website called **ParentPay** you will be able to pay online using your credit or debit card or continue to make cash payments at PayPoint stores. **ParentPay** will be our preferred method of making payments to school.
