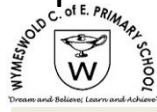


# Autumn Term Newsletter 1

### **WYMESWOLD COMMUNITY SPEEDWATCH 2022 - VOLUNTEERS NEEDED**

Hello parents and carers

We are delighted to have the community speedwatch back in Wymeswold. This 2 week event was last held in 2018 with over 100 vehicles recorded as speeding, some with speeds exceeding 60mph! We want to help make Wymeswold a safer place for everyone and speedwatch is an important tool. It's really easy to get involved and we need your help. Simply attend the training event (*unfortunately we can only take volunteers who attend the training*) and volunteer for as many shifts as you can - there will be morning, afternoon, evening and weekend options. Each shift only last an hour and you can do as many as you want. Volunteer duties include recording vehicle information and using the speed gun to record vehicle speeds. Volunteers will work in groups of 3. Over 18s only.
